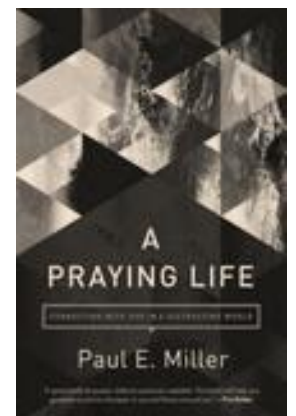
Book of the Term
