Play: All Change

All the players, except the first person who is 'It', sit in a circle. (Social distance) 'It' walks around the circle, tapping each player on the shoulder, saying 'egg' each time until he/she decides to tap someone and says 'chicken'. That person becomes the chicken and runs after 'It', trying to tag him/her before 'It' can take his seat. The new 'IT' has to choose another pair to call out like seed/flower or cloud/rain (see list above for ideas).

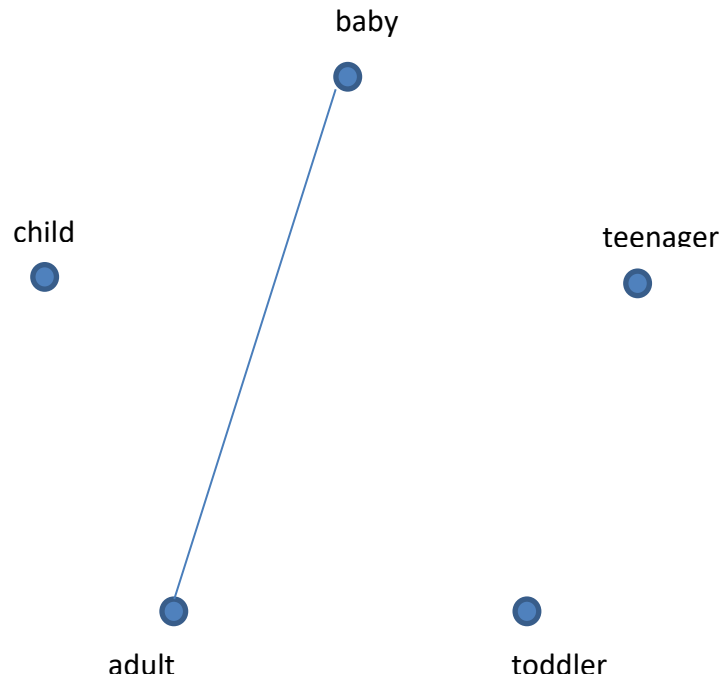
Play 4 Seasons
