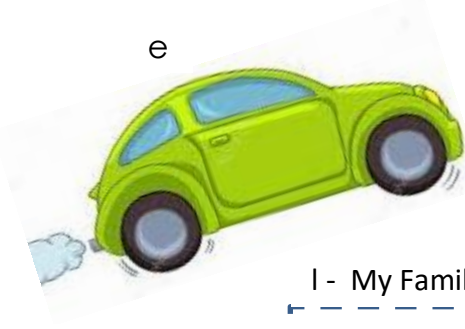

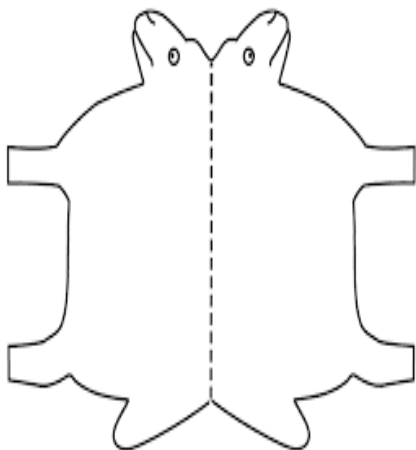

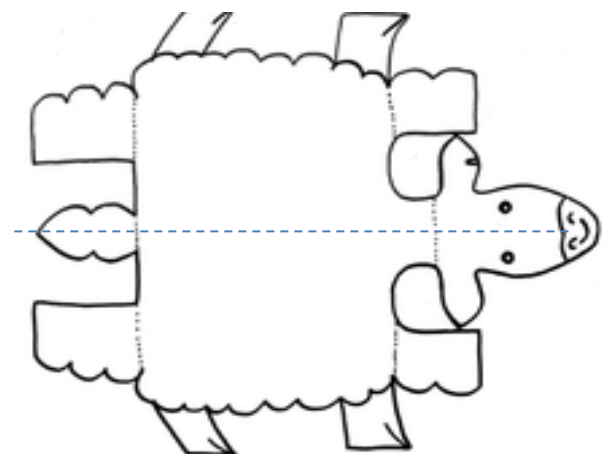

Sheep Templates

You can fill your sheepfold with lots of sheep and lambs



John 10:9-10 “I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.”



These sheep have been put out to pasture but sometimes they need to be kept safe in a sheep pen or sheep fold. The little lamb I am holding is a very poorly orphan that needs to be fed with a bottle.

Jesus is the door or gate of the sheep fold. He makes sure no thieves can get into steal his sheep. Here’s how to make a sheepfold with a very strong door. It’s a ‘ledger and brace’ door. Where might you see a door like this?



My sheepfold is made from two strips of card made from a cereal box and glued end to end. The strips are 15cm deep. You can paint your card to represent stone walls.



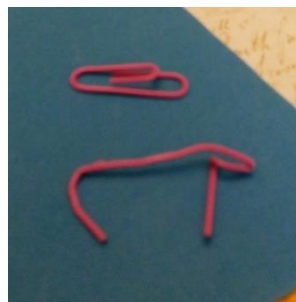
I used 6 lolly sticks glued together with PVA glue and left to dry. Check that they are in line across the top.



To make a ledger and brace door cut 3 pieces of lolly stick and glue them onto the back of the door. Measure and cut 2 braces with diagonal ends so they fit between the ledgers. Glue in place.



Cut 3 hinges on the right-hand end of the sheepfold. Measure the hinges so they match the ledgers on the door. Glue the hinges in place where you see circles (above).



Create a hook from a paperclip so it will pass through a hole in the card and hook over a drawing pin in the door.

Press a drawing pin into the front of the door and into the ledger behind. If the pin pushes through the back add a layer of card to protect your fingers. Line up with the drawing pin and make a small hole for the hook. Make some sheep for your sheep pen.
